

LESSON PLAN - STUDY SKILLS KS3 & KS4

Summary

These resources aim to introduce students to various techniques, tips and tricks to improve their revision skills. The session will encourage learners to think how best to prepare to revise, how to make the most out of their revision time and which revision methods may suit them best. By the end of the session, learners should feel that they understand better how to revise as well as having the opportunity to test out a revision method.

The main aim is

To aid in the development of learner's revision skills. This will help them as they begin to revise for GCSEs, A Levels and for university level study. The main aim is to increase their confidence with revision which is helpful to reduce stress and resistance to revising.
