

## LESSON PLAN - WEEK 7 CAREERS (2)

### Summary

The resources are split into four themes; LMI (Labour Market Information), Growth Sectors, Careers in Focus (Profiles) and Goal setting / Career Action Plan. Each theme is designed to help students recognise the key aspects of IAG, its relevance and encourage participation in managing and planning their future career.

This is a set of resources intended to enhance their careers education experiences throughout school, college and beyond and support young people to acknowledge how varieties of careers intervention, research and action planning can benefit them.

### The main aim is

Students will be able to use current LMI and career exploration toolkits to aid research and influence their career decision making skills and start to develop their own individual SMART Careers Action Plan to help motivate and raise individual aspirations.
