Shaping Futures is funded to work with young people from specific wards which have historically had high GCSE attainment and low progression to HE. In Autumn 2020, we worked with **3947** learners.

In Autumn 2020/21, Shaping Futures was unable to come into schools to deliver activities, instead appearing on screens in classrooms, or providing lesson plans and resources for teachers to deliver. We delivered 276 activities.
