<p>Session Outcomes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Learners will understand the difference between studying at a college and a university. Learners will understand the link between level 3 and Higher Education qualifications. Learners will understand what support is available to them in Higher Education and how to access it. 		
Point	Interaction	Activity
<p>Introduction Slides 1-2</p>	<p>Briefly introduce the aims of the session.</p>	
<p>What is HE? Slides 3-4</p>	<p>Ask the learners if they remember what comes after FE. Show them how they can study HE qualifications at different levels- all the way up to a PhD.</p>	
<p>Myth busting Slides 5-11</p>	<p>Go through the slides and ask learners to tell you whether the statements are true or false. Take your time with this and elaborate on them where appropriate.</p>	<p>Learners decide whether the statements on the slides are true or false.</p>
<p>What is HE like? Slides 13-17</p>	<p>Discuss how learning is different in HE- you could ask them which of the styles they're familiar with.</p> <p>Talk through a day in the life of a typical student (advocates can personalise this slide to them).</p> <p>Make the point that they will have more freedom but will be responsible for managing their own time.</p> <p>Discuss the differences between studying for a degree at college and at university.</p> <p>Mention that you can also do apprenticeships at degree level. The employer will decide what you study and where.</p>	

<p>Disabled Student Allowance Slides 19-22</p>	<p>Ask the learners what types of support they might need to live in a new place? Do they already receive these in school?</p> <p>Discuss Disabled Student Allowance using the prompts on the slides.</p> <p>If there's time, on slide 19, you can follow the link to see examples of different types of support that DSA pays for.</p>	
<p>Plenary Slide 23</p>	<p>Turn to the contents page in the booklet and get learners to mark off the pages that they have covered. If there's time you could go back and look at these in more detail.</p>	<p>Learners mark off the pages covered in their booklet.</p>
